Bloom Projects: Ro Snell, All That Is Left

Artist Ro Snell will create a new body of work for MCASB's Fall 2013 iteration of **Bloom Projects**. Drawing inspiration from her rural upbringing on a farm in England, Snell's *All That Is Left* examines the traces of what remains, after a process or a period of time, in both the physical and abstract sense.

Snell's family owned and operated farms for four generations and this work marks the end of an era for many in England, who had to abandon farming due to governmental enforced restrictions that caused economic hardship. Through photography and sculptures made from materials historically used in farm-related activities, the artist explores themes of loss, tradition and ever-changing values. *All That Is Left* celebrates a simpler and non-mechanized time and a personal attachment to the land.

Born in Malvern, England, UK, Snell currently lives and works in Santa Barbara, CA. She received her MFA from George Washington University, Washington, DC, and BFA from Brighton University of Art, England. She has exhibited at The Arts Fund Gallery, Santa Barbara, CA; Atkinson Gallery, Santa Barbara, CA; and Tinsmiths, Ledbury, England, UK.
